



CAVY WEST (Inc) HI POINT RULES



These rules are in effect from 4th March 2023.

An excel spreadsheet has been formulated for this information as of 2023. A copy of this file will be passed from points collator to points collator at every AGM. Training in its use may be required.

Champions

Blue –	Champion -	50 points required.
Red –	Double Champion -	Champion + 50 points required.
Gold –	Grand Champion -	Dbl Champion + 50 points required.

Championship points are accumulative, previous points collator will open a new excel file for the new year coming and have copied the previous year's names and points to it, that way you will have a new form to continue with and already have previous awards achieved on it. When 50 points have been reached by a cavy, they are then awarded Champion, once 100 points are reached, they are awarded Double Champion and Grand Champion at 150 points.

Animals that have been purchased from outside of WA can keep their current points and champion status, but evidence must be provided and verifiable.

Any animal shown outside of WA can accumulate points, but evidence of placings must be provided and verifiable.

Points Allocation

1st = 3 points
 2nd = 2 points
 3rd = 1 point

Best of Breed (BOB) 2 points
 Reserve of Breed (ROB) 1 point

Best Adult/Inter/Baby in Group 2 points
 Reserve Adult/Inter/Baby in Group 1 point

Best in Group 2 points
 Reserve in Group 1 point

Best Adult/Inter/Baby in Show 2 points
 Reserve Adult/Inter/Baby in Show 1 point

Best in Show 2 points
 Reserve in Show 1 point

BIS can accumulate a maximum of 13 points per show.

RIS can accumulate a maximum of 11 points per show.



CAVY WEST (Inc) HI POINT RULES



Junior of the Year

Cavy must be entered, show prepped and exhibited by the junior exhibitor.

Points to be calculated from the Junior class only.

Only 1 cavy per exhibitor shall be entered in the junior exhibitor class.

This award is based on the exhibitor not the cavy and as such a different cavy may be shown at each show.

Novice of the Year

Must be a member of Cavy West for less than 2 years to be eligible.

Cavy must be entered, show prepped and exhibited by the novice exhibitor.

Points to be calculated from the Novice class only.

Only 1 cavy per exhibitor shall be entered in the novice exhibitor class.

This award is based on the exhibitor not the cavy and as such a different cavy may be shown at each show.

Stud of the Year

Only cavies with your Stud Prefix are eligible.

Cavies must be entered by one of the eligible Stud Prefix owners.

Awarded to the Stud with the highest points earned from 1 breed they exhibit with their prefix.

Junior Stud of the Year

Junior must have their own Stud Prefix.

Cavies must be entered with junior's stud prefix to be eligible.

Awarded to the Stud with the highest points earned from 1 breed they exhibit with their prefix.
