



# CAVY WEST (Inc) Show Information



## Show Rules

- Show will be conducted under the ANCC rules and in conjunction with Cavy West rules.
- Entry Fees and any arrears owed to the Club must be paid to the Treasurer/Show Secretary on the morning of the show or prior to the show.
- Entries that are scratched or withdrawn must still be paid for.
- Minimum age for all entries is 3 months on the day of the show. This includes Condition/Pet entries.
- Please note a Family Membership is required if more than one member of the family wishes to exhibit. A single membership (Junior or Adult) only allows that person to exhibit.
- "Biosecurity" is Everyone's responsibility. If there is a chance a cavy may have, or has been exposed to something contagious, leave it at home.
- Cavies must be shown on an approved show mat.
- Inappropriate behaviour including but not limited to abuse, bullying, swearing, etc, will not be tolerated.

## General Information

- A Cavy may only be entered in one class at any show, except for duplicate classes.
- Age Group: Adult (Over 9 months), Inter/Intermediate (6-9 months), Baby (3-6 months)
- The date of birth (DOB) must be stated for Intermediate, Baby and Veteran entries, If the DOB is not provided the exhibit will be placed in the adult class.
- An asterisk (\*) means the Variety / Colour must be stated on the entry form.
- Where there are three boars and three sows in an age group within a class, that age group will be further divided on sex

## Duplicate Classes

- Entry for duplicated classes is Free.
- Duplicate classes will not be taken on the day.
- Duplicate entries must also be entered in their exhibition class.
- Only one entry per person per duplicate class allowed. Please indicate your entry for each class in the duplicate column on the entry form. There will be no substitutions on the day.
- Please indicate whether you are Novice or Junior by ticking the boxes on the entry form.
  - Junior exhibitors must be aged 18 years or less on the day of the show.
  - Novice – must be a member of Cavy West Club for less than 2 years.
  - Junior or Novice exhibitors may only enter one exhibit in the junior or novice class.
- Veterans must be over 3 years old on day of the show.

## Show Boxes

- Exhibitors must provide their own cages. Must be an approved display cage.
- Only one exhibit per cage or compartment.
- No loose, dusty bedding is allowed in show hall eg: shavings, sawdust, hay or similar.
- All cages must be fitted with a filled water bottle.

## On Show Day

- Numbered ear stickers must be worn on the cavies left ear, except longhairs: where it is to be placed on the top left corner of the show board.
- All exhibitors should make themselves available for stewarding (Please inform Show Manager if you are not available)
- Show participants should help in setting up and breaking down the show, including cleaning the hall. Please arrive for 8am to help.
- No grooming is allowed at shows, except for spot grooming and preparation of Longhairs.

### For Sale Tables

- A \$5.00 charge is payable to Cavy West for all For Sale tables, please indicate on entry form if you wish to have a sale table, this includes Cavies for sale. One Table per exhibitor/Stud.
- Cavies and other items can be sold at your table, you are responsible for all your own For Sales.
- All FOR SALES must be clean, in excellent health and a minimum weight of 250g.
- For sale tags with details must be attached to cages.
- If at no fault of the buyer there is a problem within a month with a Cavy that is sold – it must be replaced.
- All buyers are to be provided with contact details for Cavy West, the seller to provide further information if required.
- The Minimum price for a cavy is \$35.00
- NO Sow can be sold to a member of the public if it is possibly pregnant.
