## Important Information

### Show rules

- Shows will be conducted under ANCC rules in conjunction with Cavy West rules.
- Entry Fees and any arrears owed to the club must be paid to the show secretary on the morning of the show.
- Entries that are scratched or withdrawn must still be paid for.
- Minimum age for all entries is three months on the day of the show. This includes pet entries.

### Information on the entry form

- Age Groups: A = Adult (over 9 months)    B = Intermediate (6 – 9 months)    C = Baby (3 -under 6 months)
- The Date of Birth (DOB) must be stated for Intermediate and Baby and Veteran entries. If the DOB is not provided the exhibit will be placed in the adult class.
- An asterisk (\*) means the variety/colour must be stated on the entry form. Where there are three or more entries of one variety/colour the breed will get its own class.

- A cavy may only be entered in one class at any one show, except for duplicate classes.
- Entry for duplicate & handler classes are free. Entries must be entered in their breed class. Only one entry per duplicate class is allowed. Please indicate your entry for each class in the duplicate column of the entry form with N for Novice, J for Junior and/or H for handler. Entries for duplicate, handler and members pet classes will not be taken on the day.
- Juniors: Junior exhibitors must be aged 18 years or less on December 31<sup>st</sup> 2011
- Novice members must have been members of a Cavy Club for less than two years.
- Handlers need enter breed only, cavy name is not required.

#### **Show boxes**

- Exhibitors must provide their own show cage. Cavies must be shown in Cavy West white show cage or an approved cavy carrier.
- No loose, dusty bedding allowed in the show hall i.e. shavings, sawdust, hay or similar.
- All cages must be fitted with a filled water bottle.

#### **On Show Day**

- Numbered ear stickers must be worn on the cavies left ear, except longhairs; where it is to be placed on the top left hand corner of the show board.
- All exhibitors should make themselves available for stewarding (Please inform the show manager if you cannot be available).
- No grooming is allowed at shows except for spot grooming and preparation of Longhairs.

#### **For Sale Cavies**

- All For Sale cavies will be inspected prior to being allowed to put up for purchase. All cavies considered too small (under 200 grams) or in some way not in perfect health, will not be allowed to be sold.
- All purchasers will be given a card with Cavy West contacts and the sellers name, in case the purchaser should want further information or if there is a problem with the cavy.
- All cavies will be \$35 each, with \$5 going to the club for each cavy sold.
