Apart from a quick last minute 'brush up' and Longhairs, NO GROOMING allowed at shows. If it is not groomed before the show you will have to put it on the table ungroomed!

## Editor's Rant

Many thanks to those who have contributed to this newsletter, it is much appreciated.

For those that would like an update on "Guinea Chook" she is now fully grown and laying eggs. She had a cage of her own but I let her out while I am feeding the cavies. However I have to watch her as she is a bully and if I am not careful, she gets into the cavies cage and pecks them! Ungrateful bird. I think she is finally getting the idea that going outside and scratching in the dirt is better than trying to pinch the guinea pigs food.

## UTERINE PROLAPSE

Has anyone had event of Uterine Prolapse?

It is a condition where the Sow gives birth and then continues to push out one, or two, horns of the uterus immediately follow parturition. Fortunately it is mostly only the one horn.

The Sow usually goes in a corner away from her new pups and when picked up a gigantic fleshy 'thing' is seen coming out of her birth canal. Quick action is of utmost importance. Prepare a bucket of soapy water deep enough to dip her rear end in. Dip it in and lift her out to clean any bits of dirt off the uterus. This has best results if you use a syringe, fill it with the soapy solution and squirt the bits off.

You will already have soapy hands but make sure they are really soapy. Begin at the part of the uterus which is at the entrance of the vagina and using your middle finger push the prolapse into the vagina' segment by segment until it is all inside. At this point push your middle finger into the vagina for the full length of your finger. Hold it there and hang the Sow head down so that she is vertically upside down. This seats the uterine horn in place. Keep her in this position for as long as comfortable. Gently turn her horizontal and slowly remove your finger. Still in this position place a pad or thick towel against her vagina to act as a pressure pad. Rest the Sow still horizontal, on her back, in your arms for a while keeping the pad against her. Follow up with injections (I prefer intermuscular in the thigh) of OXYTOCIN @ 0.2ml (to shrink the uterus,) ANTIBIOTIC (Baytril or similar) @ 0.4ml (to prevent infection) and VIT B12 @ 0.06ml (to assist in general wellbeing.)

Gently place her back with her pups and ensure that she is eating.

I have had great success with this procedure and the Sows have fully recovered and have had healthy litters afterwards with no incidence of repeat prolapse.

Let's hope it never happens to you but if it does, remember you must be quick or you will lose your Sow.

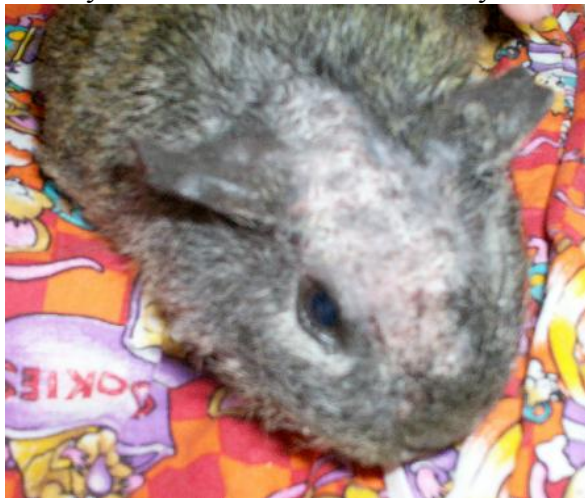
# Rosemary

## From Rags to Riches!

During one very hot day in January, 2009, we received a call from our local stock feeders telling us they had a guinea brought into them which was in a rather bad way. They asked us if we wanted to give her a loving home and look after her, not knowing what was wrong with her we agreed and went to get her. When we arrived they showed us where this little guinea pig's cage was. We could not believe our eyes; in this cage was a small creature with sores covering most of her head and neck. We picked her up gently and she had several seizures in our arms and would pass out for a few seconds then come back to us. "She is badly affected by mites which have probably been troubling her for years" is what our local vet had to say. That afternoon we took her home not knowing if she was going to survive or not, this poor cavy we decided to call "Rosemary."



We prepared a clean and warm cage, with plenty of nutritious food and water, for her, and then it was time to give her a bath. This was not going to be easy. First of all the scabs and wounds had to be cleaned carefully with special shampoo and creams. Over many weeks we gave her a series of baths to clean off all the dead skin and infection from her head. For many weeks Rosemary would just pass out as her skin was so very sore and sensitive, but we were determined to save our little Rosemary. After almost three weeks of needles, creams, treatments and baths Rosemary was starting to make slow progress.

The hair on her body started to grow back and we began to see some personality shine in her. Within seven months she had put on weight and we could now pick her up with no worries of her having a seizure. We took a wild chance and decided we could turn her into a show animal. We chose to enter Rosemary into the pet section at our guinea pig club: Cavy-West. Much to our delight the judge said she was great and we should enter her into the proper Rex class. The news kept getting better, with Rosemary entered in her class, nerves were running high. The judge went up and down the table carefully scanning every guinea pig to choose a winner.

What an honour, the judge had picked Rosemary for first place and eventually becoming 'Best Course coat' and winning a trophy! It's just a wonderful feeling to know she is good enough to put on the show table. We think Rosemary now can become a champion, with a few wins from several shows now. "Champion Rosemary", it has a nice ring to it doesn't it?



Win or lose we love our Rosemary, and when we think back to what she was like when we got her, compared to what she looks like now, is just a fabulous feeling. We are glad she is with us and she will always be a very special guinea pig!

## Trip to the National Show 2010

Having only been to the National Show once before in 1993, which turns out to be SEVENTEEN years ago, (my goodness), I was determined to attend this year. I have also been lucky to have other people exhibit my cavies on two other occasions at Nationals. To do it justice, I kept my good sows in show condition and not bred (for the first time ever) and came to the Anniversary Show for a practice run!

My father built me two lightweight wooden, varnished freight boxes, and Barbara lent some expandable plastic crates that proved very useful. I entered 7 guinea pigs and took two silver dutch over that were sold to Marilyn Gent in Tasmania. My guinea pigs went to Australian Air Express at 4am on the Thursday and set off on their cargo journey - our flight left at 7.30 as it was late. I was lucky to have our eldest daughter Meg in Melbourne, who collected me and we drove the 6 hours to Narrandera that same afternoon. Very tired, relieved, and excited, we enjoyed a pub tea and lovely accommodation in the Gateway Motel, where the GP's were parked in a locked shed with several other exhibitors animals. Other people kindly shared picked grass for mine which relaxed them a bit.

Friday was to sightsee and shop, clean out the cages, and I was very surprised that my Tuesday evening bathing and coat conditioning was still holding up well, and they only needed a soft brushing and a quick wipe with a damp microfibre cloth. The All Transit motel proprietors hosted a Friday evening dinner with a lively crowd of folk who all knew each other well. Email correspondent and fellow T/W breeder from Tasmania, Marilyn Gent and her daughter Trish joined us at our table for a lovely meal, and later Jo Livingstone and her husband Paul introduced themselves, so we really did have a splendid evening with new found friends.



National Show

Saturday - the big day and a bit on edge about getting there on time etc. Proved very close and easy, and a HUGE, brightly lit, varnished board floored basketball stadium with excellent viewing and heaps of room, also a canteen and a hamburger/sausage sizzle tent courtesy of a local Narrandera group. The three long judging tables were arranged in a U shape, and the judges were Elizabeth Hodsdon (MEGWEN STUD, NSW) for all the Marked Breeds. Gordon Plain (HEDON STUD, QLD) did the Satins, Cresteds, and Peter Wright (HEDON STUD, Qld) did the Sells. Melanie Barnes was the Show Secretary. Classes began to roll, and things got a bit exciting and hectic for a while.

For me, it was more a "Convention for Excited and Enthusiastic Torty and White Breeders and Exhibitors of Australia" than a National Show!!! Peter and Matt Ricci, Melanie Barnes, myself, with Jo Livingstone, Marilyn Gent and Phillip Davis all fielded beautiful Torty and Whites - a very strong contest. (I'd only gone because someone had said there were hardly any T/W left being shown at the National!! They'd had a resurgence!) We had SIX in the Boars, and there were some rippers. Poor Elizabeth Hodsdon steadfastly judged while we rather excitedly whispered about the good features and faults of

My 3yo sow CLOVER-LEAF SHOWPIECE was 1st, my young sow CLOVER-LEAF COURTESAN was 2nd and Peter and Matt's lovely POLYTELIS BABY G came third. Melanie Barnes had a terrific young T/W in the Intermediates, and he won - BUMBORA PSYCHEDELIC BLUR.

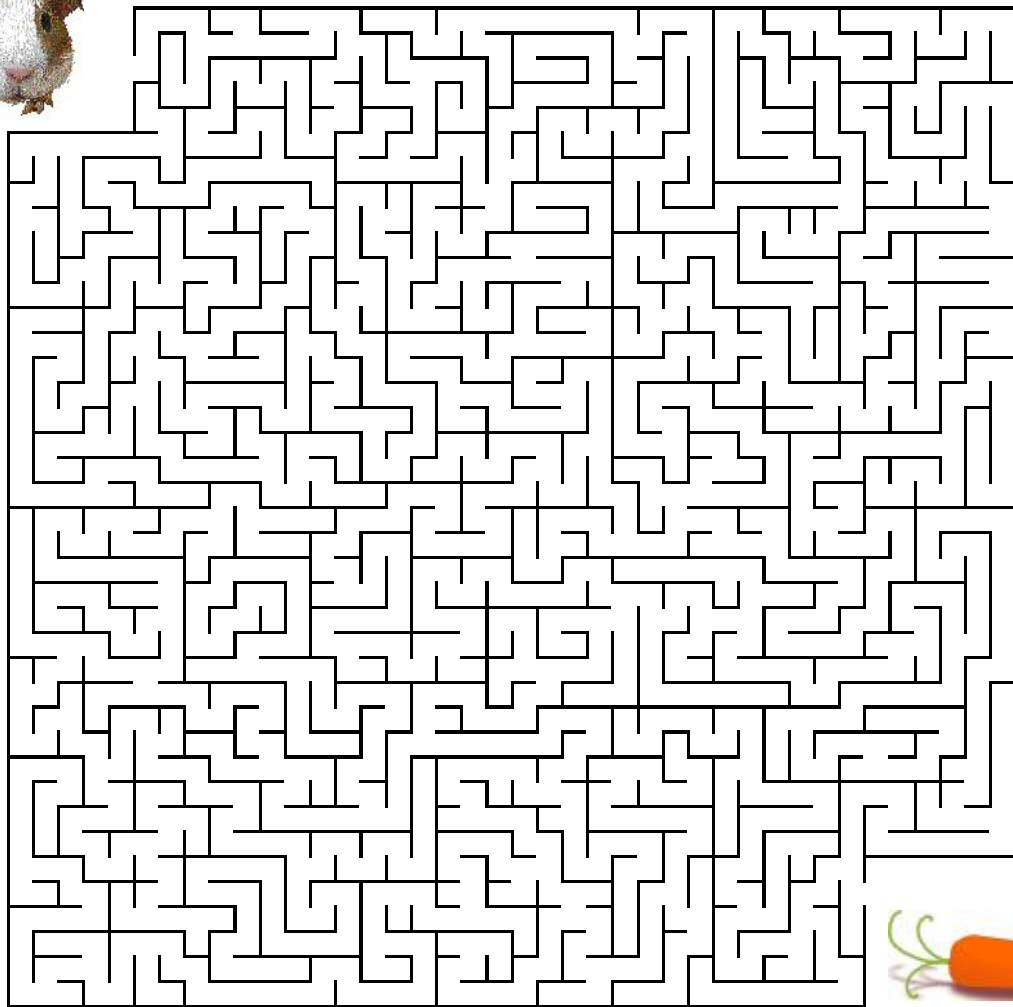

It finished up pretty tidily about 5pm, and we had a couple of hours before the Presentation Dinner in Narrandera. This was well filled, and David Barne's MC'd a lively evening with many, many presentations. I got to present 'my' trophy - the Jack Whitworth Trophy for the Best T/W Bred and owned by an Exhibitor to a very appreciative Meryl Gent, and so it went down to Tasmania for the first time. That brought the wonderful experience to a close, and the next day, Meg and I sight-see'd our way back down to Melbourne, visited the National Gallery of Victoria, the Tim Burton Exhibition at the Australian Centre for the Moving Image (where she works) and took in the very moving TITANIC exhibition at the Museum. And that was it, barring the flight home, and long drive home. The guineas got very accepting of the transport and cage confinement and ate well. It had been a bit laborious cleaning out their little pens and I got through large quantities of sawdust and the donated kitty litter absorbent bedding, but I had also managed to bring home two new Bumbora T/W sows, so it was a terrific experience.

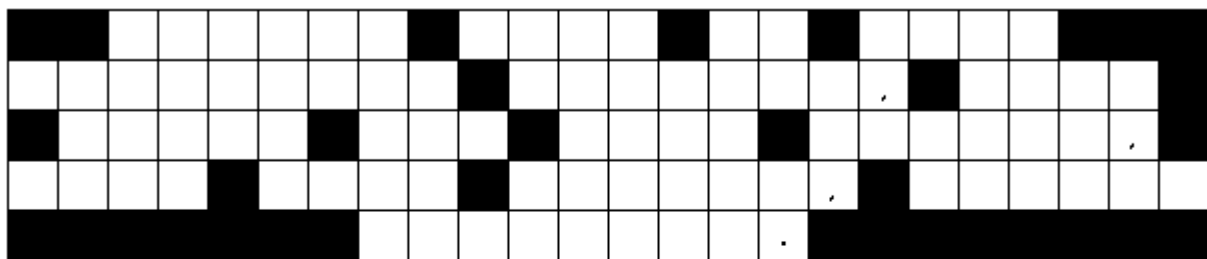

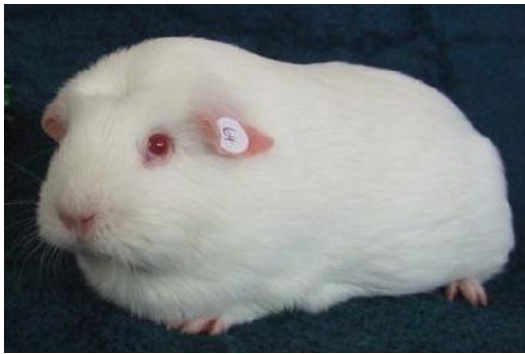
