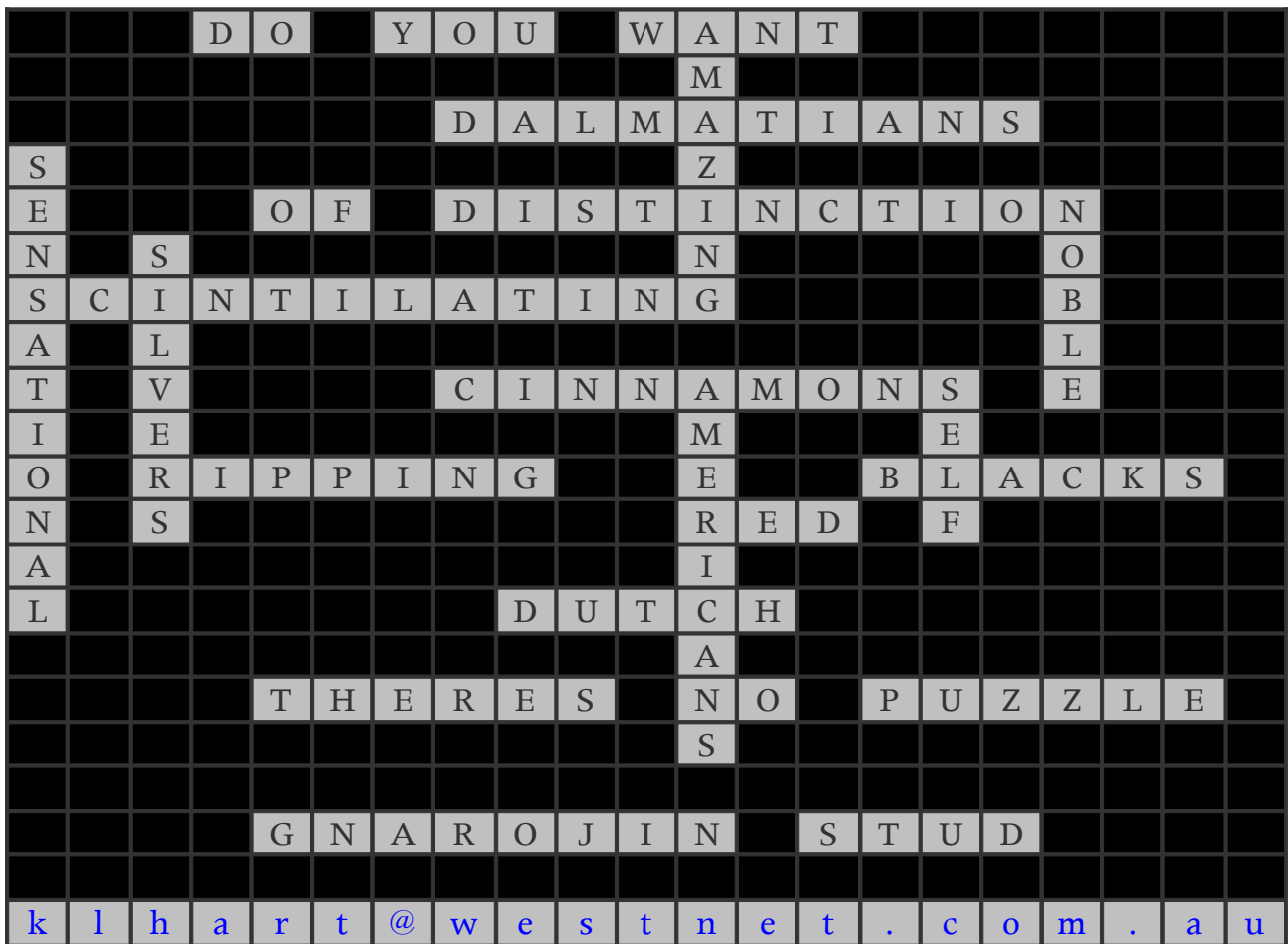

Fungus Fighting

Due to many reasons, including the long warm, damp winter weather we had, problems with Fungus Infections was more common than usual this year, but it is possible to get a Fungus problem at any time of the year.

How does your cavy get an Fungus Infection? The answer is, very easily! Fungus spores can be airborne as well as being on any object, including the cavies' food or hay or whatever. Anything can carry Fungus spores, and any animal can be infected by Fungus, INCLUDING YOU, so be careful when handling any cavy with a Fungal infection. It is best to use gloves but at least wash well after handling/treating any cavy with a fungal infection.

For those who do not have the internet, a fungus infection is usually, but not always, found on the shorter haired areas of the cavy, often on the face, belly or legs of a cavy. However they can be found anywhere on a cavy. Usually noticed as a bald spot of flaky, itchy skin. As it is so irritating, the cavies scratching can cause bleeding wounds. Some cavies can show irritated/aggressive attitude if they are touch on, or close to, the area of the fungus infection, this seems especially so for those that have the infection in the middle of the back where they can not scratch it. Often you are unaware of the infection until a patch of hair falls out. Very annoying if it is just before a show!

Another common way of getting a fungus infection is through a carrier. These cavies do not show any sign of having an infection but they are carrying it and can infect any cavy that is contact with it, or some cavy on the other side of the shed! You can have a large group of cavies in together but only some will get it. For one, some seem to have a natural immunity to it, other are just plain lucky as the fungal spore did not land in a good spot to start an infection. Fungus spores can sit dormant for years, so do not be surprised if it shows up, weeks or even months after you think you have got rid of it. Disinfecting

everything in sight will help, but not guarantee, that you will not get a further infection.

Treatment.

Fortunately it is fairly easy to treat and lots of ways of treating it. There are topical creams, dips, oral treatments and natural oils. I have tried different ones at different times and they all work, some better than others.

As I said earlier, you can catch a fungal infection from your cavy yourself, well I managed to do just that, not once but twice, but it was a good opportunity see which worked the best on me as well as on the cavies. Not just on how quickly it eradicated the infection but also how it soothed the itchiness. I will go from the best to the not so good.

Quit-Itch. (There are other similar products with different names.) A broad spectrum antiseptic, fungicide treatment. Can be bought at most Stockfood stores, pet shows and Vets. You should always have some Quit-Itch, or similar product, on hand. Follow the directions of washing the cavy in it and also apply it full strength to the affected area. Washing the cavy in it also helps prevent further infections and treats any area you are not yet aware of.

Using on myself, I found it was by far the best for soothing the itching. It worked better on the cavies than it did on me, probably because they did not keep washing off!

Oral treatments, they work but are a bit expensive and does nothing for the itchiness. A topical treatment also needs to be applied.

Topical treatments. Any fungal cream, including Athletes Foot treatments, ringworm cream, etc. It does not matter if they are for people or animals, they are much the same. They work but did not work as quickly as Quit-Itch and are not as good at soothing the itching either.

Natural oils, like Teatree Oil, and Eucalyptus Oil. There are other oils but I only tried these two. They worked, but very slowly, they were also a bit more messy and especially in the case of Eucalyptus Oil, very smelly! Cure your blocked sinus at the same time! They also were nowhere as good as Quit-Itch for soothing the irritation, and believe me it does need soothing!

Help, What is Fatty Eye....

Just what is Fatty Eye? It is the permanent protrusion of the lower conjunctiva sac. It looks smooth and white in appearance and bulges out over the lower eyelid. It does not bother the pig at all, but it does bother the owner/breeder who can not show the said pig! It is said to be inherited but unfortunately it does not tend to appear until the pig is older, often after the pig has been bred from. My advice is not to breed from any animal that has fatty eye.

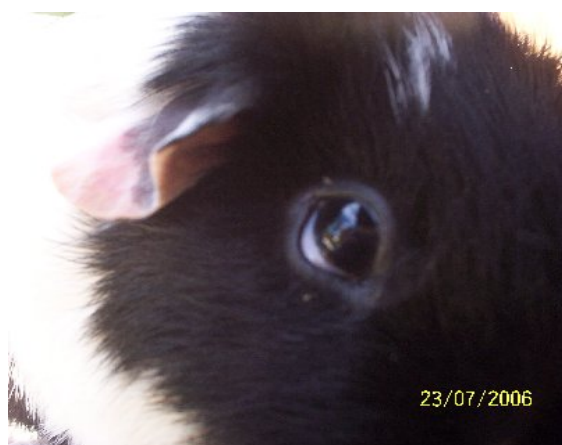
It is a disqualification if it can be seen without moving the eyelid. With this pig there is no need to move the eyelid, it is very visible. It can be in one eye or both. In this particular pig it is only in one eye, the other eye is normal.

It is most often seen in animals of good, to obese, condition. In some cases it is possible for it to go away if the pig loses weight but not always. Do not confuse Fatty Eye with Red Eye. Red Eye is in the same place but instead of smooth and white it is red and often 'pebbly' looking. Unlike Fatty Eye, Red Eye can come and go and is usually the result of some irritation to the eye. Red Eye is also a disqualification.

Some pigs have very large eyes and the white of the eye can be seen, this is not Fatty Eye and it is not a disqualification.

Apart from putting your pig on a diet, which may or may not work, there is no treatment for Fatty Eye. At least I did not think so but I found out that it is possible to have the eye operated on and have some of the excess retrobulbar fat removed. I have not heard of anyone getting this done but personally I think that if a pig has Fatty Eye then they should be retired from both the show table and the breeding pen, no matter how disappointing this is.

RULES FOR THE STUD PREFIX

1. Any fancier may register and use a stud prefix. An application form together with the current registration fee must be sent to the Secretary of the applicant's club or association. The club or association will forward such applications to the ANCC Stud Registrar.

2. A stud prefix may not be used until notification of its registration is received.

3. Baby cavies generally carry the prefix of the stud at which they were born. There are exceptional circumstances where a sow has a litter away from her own stud. In these cases the litter carries the stud prefix of the legal owner of the sow.

4. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES is the name of a cavy to be changed. It MUST RETAIN ITS ORIGINAL NAME GIVEN BY THE BREEDER, both stud prefix and given name.

5. A stud cavy's FULL NAME must be shown on any pedigree relating to itself or to its offspring.

6. A stud cavy's FULLNAME must be used when being shown.

7. A cavy born before the prefix is registered is not entitled to carry the prefix.

8. Any cavy purchased at a pet shop or which is of unknown parentage may NOT carry a stud prefix. This includes babies born at a stud where the mother of those babies has come from a pet shop already pregnant.

9. When a cavy is sold the ORIGINAL pedigree form SIGNED BY THE BREEDER must accompany the animal, not a substitute signed by somebody else.

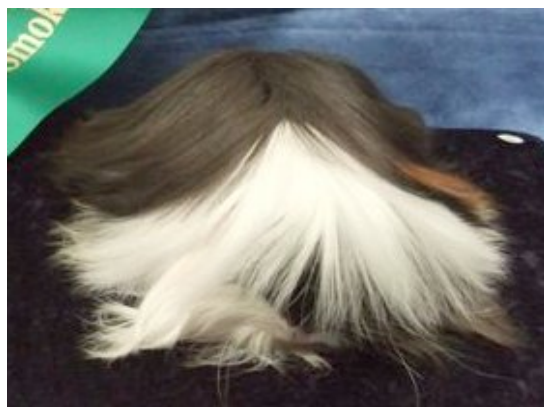
